Parking

Please park on the street near the Unitarian Church. The church is in a residential neighborhood and there is street parking near the church. Please be sensitive to area businesses and residents and be aware of driveways when parking. There will be a designated drop off zone in from of the church on Winthrop Street. You are welcome to drop off or pick up people in that loading zone. There are two reserved handicapped parking places on Summer Street near the Summer Street door. Please use those spaces if you have a tag for accessible parking.

Greeters and Security

This year, we will have many greeters to assist and welcome you. They will be wearing bright yellow tags that say "Greeter." Please approach them with any problems or questions you might have. Additionally, we have hired a uniformed Augusta police officer to be stationed outside during services. The main doors will be locked 15 minutes after each service starts. There will be a greeter to let you in after that time, but you will need to knock in order to be let into the sanctuary.

Seating

Again this year we will designate a number of seats as accessible seating. These seats will be reserved before services begin. Please use them if you need accessible seating.
