| <i>Absentee Ballots</i>           | Ballots will be available and mailed starting 1 month before Election Day   |
| <i>Absentee Ballot Submission</i> | Must be <b>received</b> by 8:00 PM Election Day (November 3)!<br>** The ADL New England and others recommend mailing the ballot at least 2 weeks before Election Day to avoid postal delays due to increased volume of mailed ballots. ** |
